INVITATION FOR TENDERS

Procurement of Installation of meters and auxiliary equipment

This Invitation for Tenders follows the General Procurement Notice for this project which was published on the EBRD Web Site, Procurement Notices (www.ebrd.com) for Phase I initially published on 4 November 2009 and updated as needed.

Montenegrin Electric Enterprise - Elektroprivreda Crne Gore AD Nikšić (EPCG), hereinafter referred to as “the Employer”, intends using part of the proceeds of a loan from the European Bank for Reconstruction and Development (the Bank) towards the cost of EPCG Metering and Distribution Project – Phase II.

The Employer now invites sealed tenders from contractors for the following contract to be funded from part of the proceeds of the loan:

Procurement of Installation of meters and auxiliary equipment

Installation of 80,000 meters (2014-2016)

Tenders are invited for one single Contract.

Tendering for contracts to be financed with the proceeds of a loan from the Bank is open to firms from any country.

To be qualified for the award of a contract, tenderers must satisfy the following minimum criteria:

Minimum average annual turnover of EUR 15 million EUR within the last five (5) years

Specific Experience

- a) Participation as contractor or management contractor in at least two (2) contracts within the last five (5) years, each with a value of at least EUR eleven (11) million,

that have been successfully and substantially completed and that are similar to the proposed Works. The similarity shall be based on the physical size, complexity, methods/technology or other characteristics as described in Section VI, Employer's Requirements.

- b) For the above or other contracts executed during a period of five years a minimum experience in the following key activities: 100.000 nos. of installed meters and 40.000 nos. metering points relocated.
